

Years ago, I suffered injury to my back and neck were injured in an automobile accident in Calgary. Although I did not miss much work, the lasting effects of my injury made it necessary for me to change occupations and I could no longer pursue the career that I loved.

The insurance company for the other driver kept saying that my claim was worth only \$5,000.00, because my injury was "minor" and that I had no income loss.
